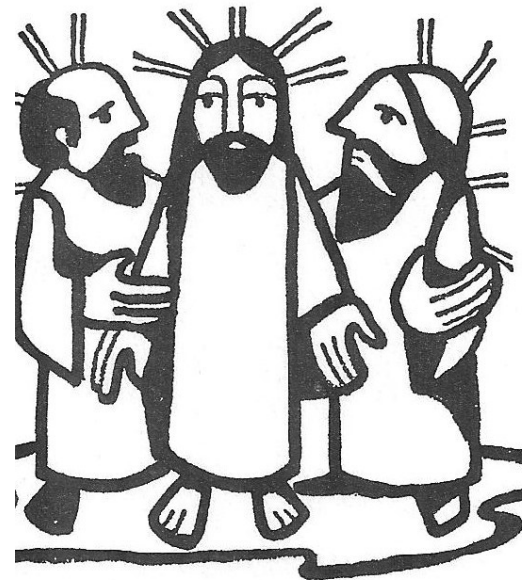

Today at 11.00 am Mass—Anointing and scrutiny for Skye

Sundays 3, 4, 5 of Lent—Scrutinies for Karen at 11.00 am Mass. Those over 14 take part in three scrutinies before baptism. As Lindsay is already baptised, she does not take part in the scrutinies.

Due to the scrutinies, the readings at the 11.00 am Mass on Sundays 3, 4, 5 of Lent will be those of Cycle A, not those of Cycle C which will be used at the Vigil Mass
