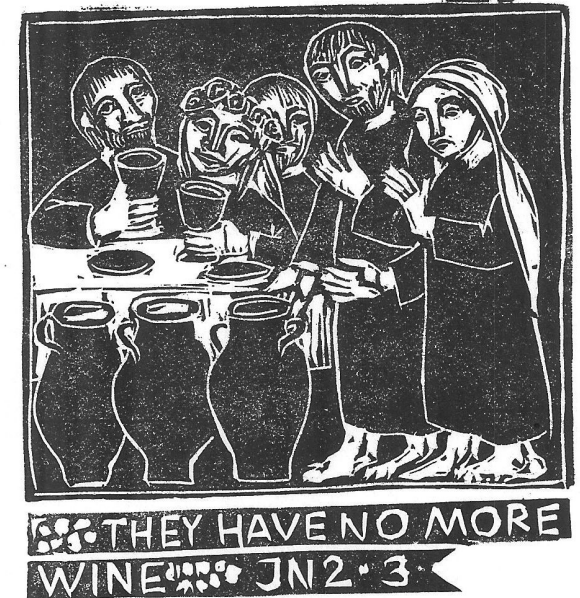

The Season of Sacraments

Over the next months the celebration of various sacraments will be taking place.

Pupils in Primary 3 at St Paul’s are due First Confession in Lent. Parents should speak to the PP as soon as possible bringing a copy of their child’s baptism certificate.

Pupils in Primary 4 who made their first confession last year are due to celebrate their First Communion on any Sunday of their choice after Easter and before Pentecost.

Anyone who has missed the Sacrament of Confirmation should speak to the Parish Priest about this and arrangements can be discussed.

Anyone who is thinking of marriage this year or even 2017 should be speaking to the Parish Priest by now. The Marriage Preparation course takes place on the first four Fridays of Lent that is beginning Friday 12th February. Please sign up as soon as possible.
