All those aged 14 and above are obliged to abstain from meat that day, all those between the ages of 18 and 59 must also fast. Fasting requires that we have only one meal that day but may have two small snacks also during the day.

Ashes will be distributed at Mass on Ash Wednesday. There will be Mass at 10.00 am and 7.00 pm on Ash Wednesday.

Each Sunday during Lent (except the 4th Sunday) there will be a special collection for the support of our sick and retired priests.
