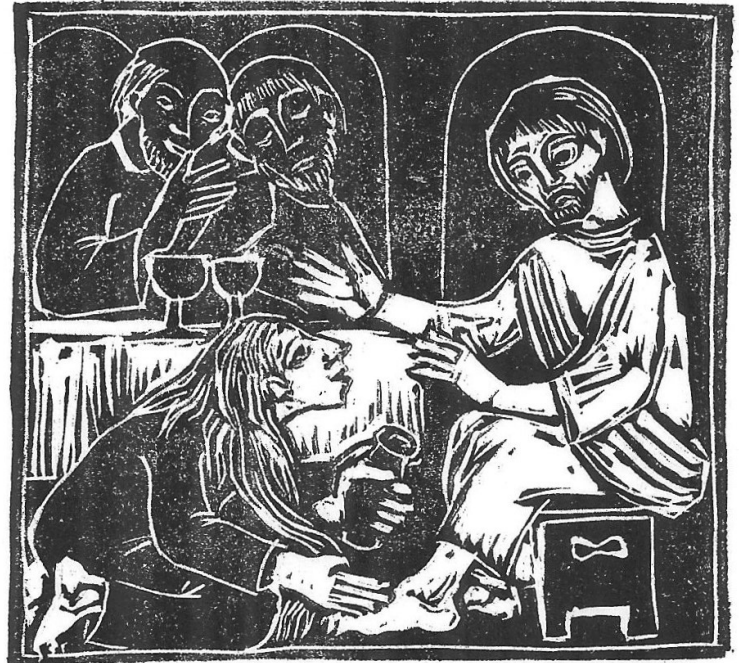

Mgr. Smith begins chemotherapy on Wednesday and then every third Wednesday until the end of September. It also appears likely that radiotherapy will also be given at some stage over the next few weeks. It is clear that we will have to take things as they come for a while. However the parish needs to function and get on with life and as you heard last week, the diocese has asked Father Celestine (who was here when Mgr. Smith first arrived) to come and live temporarily in St Pauls. Another priest from Ghana will be arriving in the diocese in a short time on loan for two years and he is being assigned full time to Saint Paul's for the immediate future. Father Celestine will then return to St Margaret's. This means that Mgr. Smith can move on with treatment and St Paul's can move on too. Mgr. Smith will also be able to be involved where possible.

Webcast—we have had a problem with the webcast due to a BT fault which has taken some time and three call outs to correct. We are at the final stages in getting the repair completed and the webcast should be up again soon. Sorry for the inconvenience.
