### Mission Sunday—23 October

#### Ethiopian Orthodox Church

One of the oldest Rites of the Christian Church, the Ethiopian Orthodox Church is not in Communion with the Holy See but is a Christian Church of ancient origin. We have been asked to allow this Community to use our church for the feast day and after consultation with the Archbishop it has been agreed that the October 8th Feast day liturgy may be celebrated here. The Liturgy begins at 2.00 am (yes) and finishes around noon (yes). To allow this Liturgy to take place our Saturday morning Mass on 8th October will be celebrated in the parish house. Anyone who wishes to attend this Orthodox Liturgy may do so, but out of respect for the tradition of their Church and ours, we should not take part in Holy Communion at the Liturgy.
